

# CHÂTEAU LA COUDRAIE 2016

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## BORDEAUX AOC

*GOLD Medal - Concours de Lyon 2017*



Gold Medal winning, Young purple/ruby colour. The nose is fresh and shows finesse with its hints of fruit (strawberry and cherries), flowers, spices and leaves that are logically restrained in such a young wine. Its youth shows also on the palate, which appears energetic and firm, with pleasant fruit flavours over a tannic structure that is still marked. This will soften and blend in a year or so to make for a classically seductive ensemble.

### Grape Varieties:

60% Merlot

20% Cabernet Franc

20% Cabernet Sauvignon

This blended Bordeaux is all planted on clay / limestone soils.

If you've ever thought clarets were too austere, this wine will convert you. Ripe and fruit forward, it's a very moreish Bordeaux from the family property of top viticulturer Jean-Marc Jolivet, brimming with creamy plum and cassis fruit.
